Beginner Bird Walks

Take a walk in the park and experience the fascinating variety of birds found in the Las Cruces area!

Join our bird walks at Tellbrook Park on the **3rd Wednesday of the month**, guided by a member of the Mesilla Valley Audubon Society, and observe the ever changing birdlife that lives and visits here. Our birding will be done from the paved path that winds through the park; however, if there is interest, we may also make a short (optional) excursion into the surrounding desert.

Meet at **7:45 AM** at the entrance to **Tellbrook Park at 4290 E. Winchester Rd. in the Las Alturas area**. This is a residential neighborhood with limited parking, so please be courteous and do not block driveways. Bird walks will last about an hour.

These walks are appropriate for beginners. You do not need prior experience to enjoy it. Although not necessary, a pair of binoculars will greatly improve how well you see the birds. Dress appropriately for the weather and bring drinking water. And bring your curiosity and thirst for the outdoors!
